the dates of the four vedas as well as the homeland of the indo european speaking people have been two unresolved issues in the indian history this book uses the robust information recently emerging from archaeo botanical studies particularly palinology as well as that originating from the researches in geology archaeology and genetics the information generated from these scientific studies provides a vivid picture of the last ten thousand years of europe and asia this picture has been matched against the information about the plants animals and climate contained in the four vedic samhitas as well as that emerging from the philological studies the final picture emerges that the rig veda was composed between 8000 bc and 6000 bc sama veda between 6000 bc and 5500 bc yajur veda between 5500 bc and 2500 bc or perhaps 2000 bc and the atharva veda between 1500bc and 1300 bc the investigation also reveals that the indo european words for lion kesari singh camel ustra ostrich opium lotus etc characteristically indian animals and plants have existed in the indo european vocabulary although not noticed so far that exercise fixes the location of the indo european homeland in northwest india at about 10 000 8 000 bc

this book argues that the indo europeanizing of europe essentially began shortly before 1600 bc when lands rich in natural resources were taken over by military forces from the eurasian steppe and from southern caucasia first were the

copper and silver mines along with good harbors in greece and the copper and gold mines of the carpathian basin by ca 1500 bc other military men had taken over the amber coasts of scandinavia and the metalworking district of the southern alps these military takeovers offer the most likely explanations for the origins of the greek keltic germanic and italic subgroups of the indo european language family battlefield warfare and militarism robert drews contends were novelties ca 1600 bc and were a consequence of the military employment of chariots current opinion is that militarism and battlefield warfare are as old as formal states going back before 3000 bc another current opinion is that the indo europeanizing of europe happened long before 1600 bc the kurgan theory of marija gimbutas and david anthony dates it from late in the fifth to early in the third millennium bc and explains it as the result of horse riding conquerors or raiders coming to europe from the steppe colin renfrew s archaeology and language dates the indo europeanizing of europe to the seventh and sixth millennia bc and explains it as a consequence of the spread of agriculture in a wave of advance from anatolia through europe pairing linguistic with archaeological evidence drews concludes that in greece and italy at least no indo european language could have arrived before the second millennium bc

over the last few decades archaeologists and cultural scientists have come to a better understanding of the extent of neolithic civilisation on the balkan peninsula this danube civilisation thriving between the 6th and 4th millennia bce was using a writing system long before the mesopotamians and is remarkable for its accomplishments in craftsmanship art and urban development in this book harald haarmann provides the first comprehensive insight into this enigmatic old european culture which is still largely unknown to the greater public he describes the trade routes settlements mythology and writing system of this people traces the changes resulting from the arrival of the indo europeans and shows how this first advanced civilisation in europe influenced its successors

the current conventional harappan and indo european timelines are impossible believing in them means endorsing the idea the harappan arguably the largest civilization of the bronze age lagged thousand years technically behind the minor nations that surrounded them likewise it means their major trading partners the sumerians elamites and akkadians were all technology backwards compared to the minor nations of india central asia and even the middle of the sahara which all were smelting iron long before iron smelting was adopted by the major powers dna has now proven that the population of northern india was the same in 2400 bc as it is today which in the conventional timelines means the vedas would have had to have been written in the indus valley civilization yet the harappans mainly used boats to travel the rivers of india and there is no evidence of horses or horse burials in the indus valley civilization so why did
