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conversations about racism are as important as they are hard for american christians yet the conversation often gets so ugly even among the faithful who claim unity in jesus why is that the case why does it matter can things get better or are we permanently divided in this honest and hopeful book pastor isaac adams doesn't just show you how to have the race conversation he begins it for you by offering a fictional racially charged tragedy in order to understand varying perspectives and responses he examines what is at stake if we ignore this conversation and why there's just as much at stake in how we have that discussion especially across color lines that is with people of another ethnicity this unique approach offers insight into how to listen to one another well and seek unity in christ looking to god's word christians can find wisdom to speak gracefully and truthfully about racism for the glory of god the good of their neighbors and the building up of the church some feel that the time for talking is over and that we've heard all this before but given how polarized american society is becoming its churches not exempt fresh attention on the dysfunctional communication between ethnicities is more than warranted adams offers an invitation to faithfully combat the racism so many of us say we hate and maintain the unity so many of us say we want together we can learn to speak in such a way that we show a divided world a different world talking about race points to the starting line not the finish line when it comes to following jesus amid race relations it's high time to begin running

stories to tell the good news that Jesus has made a way out of the broken places we find ourselves churches around the world are training people to share the gospel using this method it has proven appeal across generations and cultures they've heard stories about an 8 year old boy leading his 26 year old cousin to repent and believe in Jesus and a 70 plus year old church member who had never before shared his faith leading his Spanish speaking neighbor to Christ it's been used to train the Mixtec in Mexico Maasai warriors in Kenya and prisoners in America it's been presented on napkins in concrete in the sand and using tortillas the 3 circles work and this book will train you and your church members to use it it doesn't matter if you have been a Christian for decades or days you can learn to do what God asks us to do to make His appeal to others through us 2 Cor 5:20 this short training manual will empower and inspire millions of Christians to turn hundreds of millions of everyday conversations into gospel conversations

the practical art of spiritual conversation is about the art of when if and how to engage in a spiritual conversation the whens and the ifs inform the how Christians can be so concerned with how to share the gospel that they often fail to consider where the person is spiritually and when or even if they should share the gospel to be sure the scriptures are clear that followers of Christ must spread the good news yet there are times when sharing the gospel would be undeniably inappropriate how then do gospel centered evangelistic Christians discern when to share Christ or when to stay silent what determines when and if someone is even ready to hear the gospel how does one meaningfully engage a person who has already accepted the gospel refined through tens of thousands of spiritual encounters this book provides a helpful framework for discerning where a person is spiritually and how to encourage each person to take a step toward Christ regardless of where they may presently be in their faith journey you will be equipped in the practical art of spiritual conversation so that you can meaningfully encourage every person to take a step toward Christ
