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this book offers a uniquely comprehensive account of the conflict in northern ireland providing a rigorous analysis of its dynamics and present structure and proposing a new approach to its resolution it deals with historical process communal relations ideology politics economics and culture and with the wider british irish and international contexts it reveals at once the enormous complexity of the conflict and shows how it is generated by a particular system of relationships which can be precisely and clearly described the book proposes an emancipatory approach to the resolution of the conflict conceived as the dismantling of this system of relationships although radical this approach is already implicit in the converging understandings of the british and irish governments of the causes of conflict the authors argue that only much more determined pursuit of an emancipatory approach will allow an agreed political settlement to emerge

this study of the problem of catholic and protestant discord in northern ireland was written under the sponsorship of the irish association for cultural economic and social relations the antagonism that plagues northern ireland s life is diagnosed in chapters which deal with social relations employment politics leisure and other topics

each of the jurisdictions within the uk and ireland is refining the operational characteristics of its planning system and while there are some common practices it is also the case that there are substantive divergences in each territory the planning template is fundamentally shaped within a dynamic legal context and thus students and practitioners of planning need accessible informative and up to date literature dealing with this matter planning law and practice in northern ireland provides an interpretive narrative of the statutes case law and planning procedures that have shaped its planning system with due regard being given to the combined influences emanating from european union uk and northern ireland planning governance the contributions in this book explore the evolution of planning in northern ireland and discuss key facets of development management enforcement environmental law equality property law and professional ethics this book makes an important contribution to the wider literature in this field and provides an essential reference to students planning practitioners and researchers

recent developments in northern ireland have correctly been described as historic while the future of constitutional change is by no means certain events merit close scrutiny the

good friday agreement 1998 marked a significant departure from incrementalism and thus with the dominant logic of british constitutionalism the agreement is in essence a constitutional promise anchored in clear normative principles although several aspects of the agreement are in operation there is no guarantee that this new form of constitutionalism will work however the foundations of the settlement are clear the building blocks reflect a strong commitment to human rights equality and democratic renewal which encompasses a multiplicity of overlapping relationships this book examines several key aspects of this complex picture developments in northern ireland have attracted a large measure of international interest reflecting this the contributors demonstrate the links to current controversies in constitutional and human rights law scholarship at a time when there is much consideration of constitutional change in the uk and beyond the intention is to offer a collection that both describes the changing legal and political landscape in northern ireland and one which provides a significant contribution to current debates on constitutionalism

this book addresses the topical question of northern ireland s peace process and the manner in which it was negotiated

in societies suffering from acute political and social cleavage policing agencies are invariably at the heart of the conflict resolution processes in northern ireland there have been calls for the ruc to be disbanded as well as for it to be retained unchanged after considering various options and models especially from spain south africa and the netherlands this book charts a path for reform that takes account of northern ireland s political realities and will help build trust and inclusions

drawing on original research into explosive evidence which had been concealed for twenty five years this book offers a devastating critique of the official widgery inquiry into the massacre of innocent and unarmed civilians by british soldiers on bloody sunday it exposes the inquiry as a gross denial of justice and the rule of law expert analysis of the subordination of law to security policy in northern ireland reveals that the bloody sunday experience is an integral part of a sustained pattern belated prospects for a restoration of justice and the rule of law are found in the good friday peace agreement and the unprecedented establishment of a second tribunal of inquiry into bloody sunday

consociational power sharing in northern ireland from leading scholars in the field explores the evolution and challenges of consociational power sharing in northern ireland for politics and societal relations contributors to this book highlight that scholarship on consociational democracy anticipates political stability and continuous integration in post

conflict societies however over 25 years on from the good friday agreement concerns remain about the adequacy of consociational power sharing to ensure a fully functional form of government capable of providing stability and of addressing deeper political and social issues while violence is absent ethno national identities remain in a state of a fragile equilibrium and aspirations for significant progress on key issues like truth justice mutual respect and socio political inclusion have not been met the reasons as to why this is so and what can be done to rectify it are central to the arguments that animate this timely book consociational power sharing in northern ireland will be of great interest to students and scholars in political science law and constitutionalism nationalism and ethnicity and those interested in related topics in sociology and criminology it will also appeal to practitioner communities related to power sharing political representation and constitutional politics

though forced displacement constituted a central and pervasive feature of the northern ireland troubles effecting tens of thousands of citizens remarkably it has been afforded little more than a footnote or fleeting reference in most accounts of the conflict this book seeks to end the silence surrounding this neglected and ubiquitous aspect of the conflict based on 88 in depth qualitative interviews with victims and survivors and extensive secondary research this fascinating study provides the first comprehensive examination of forced displacement in northern ireland the analysis presented captures the unique perspectives of those forcibly uprooted over the course of the 30 year conflict and places on historical record their stories and experiences this thought provoking work challenges and broadens prevailing understandings of conflict related violence harm and loss in northern ireland to demonstrate the centrality of forced movement territory and demographics to the roots and subsequent trajectory of the troubles in doing so it shows that to fully understand the eruption and outplaying of the troubles and its elusive peace engagement with and understanding of the legacy of forced displacement is crucial

northern ireland has a complex urbanism with multilayered socio spatial politics in this environment issues of communication self representation and expression of identity are central to the experience of urban space and architecture where the dichotomy of division and shared living are spatially exercised in everyday life unlike other studies in the area this book focuses on the everyday experiences of local communities in both public and private spheres issues of shareness challenging conventional approaches to divided cities the book aims to layer its narratives of architectural and social developments as an urban experience in post conflict settings over the past two decades

political accommodation in northern ireland israel and south africa at the macro level may

not by itself be sufficient to achieve the long term goals of building peace and reconciliation this book uses lederach s peace building model to explore issues which may provide a basis for transformation and a lasting peace in the three countries

this book provides a detailed exploration of the responses of the criminal justice system to domestic abuse in northern ireland the book s primary focus is on developments which have taken place since around 2010 and in particular since the restoration of the northern ireland assembly in january 2020 after a three year suspension the book includes discussion of the increased levels of domestic abuse in northern ireland in the context of the covid 19 pandemic and analyses the ways in which the criminal justice system responded in addition the book includes in depth discussion of the domestic abuse and civil proceedings act northern ireland 2021 which had the effect of criminalising coercive control and the implications of this legislation for northern ireland s response to domestic abuse the book will be of great interest to academics and researchers from a wide variety of disciplines such as criminal law criminology social policy human rights family law gender studies and sociology as well as practitioners and those in the voluntary sector who are working in the area of combating domestic abuse it can also be used on courses at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels which incorporate the topic of domestic abuse

this work provides a comprehensive introduction to british government policy in northern ireland it looks at policy in four related areas constitutional security economic and social offering an overview of the questions of continuity and bipartisanship in british policy

the politics of ulster unionism is central to the success or failure of any political settlement in northern ireland this book examines the relationship between ulster unionism and the peace process in reference to these questions

this book is an essential resource on attitudes to social and political issues in contemporary northern ireland within this report an authoritative group of academics and those involved in informing policy making within the community summarise and interpret data from the annual northern ireland life and times survey topics explored include the extent of change in attitudes centred on religion politics and community relations other topics contribute to the more general social policy debate and include health social capital lifelong learning men s issues culture and attitudes to work this is the ninth report in the series on social attitudes in northern ireland the chapters draw on data from the 2000 and 2001 northern ireland life and times surveys as well as on data from previous years thus providing an in depth examination of changing values in northern ireland

religion is traditionally portrayed as nothing but trouble in Ireland but the churches played a key role in Northern Ireland's peace process. This study challenges many existing assumptions about the peace process drawing on four years of interviewing with those involved including church leaders, politicians and paramilitary members.

Despite some improvement in theatre utilisation, waiting lists and the length of time which patients have to wait for treatment in Northern Ireland remain the worst in the UK. Using operating theatres to their optimum could directly contribute to their reduction. Following on from a Northern Ireland Audit Office report HCP 552 Session 2002/03 ISBN 0102924333 published in April 2003, the Committee's report examines options for maximising operating theatre capacity and reducing waiting lists, better theatre management and control, and the shortage of theatre staff and the limited availability of beds.

Law in Northern Ireland is the essential textbook for all students of Northern Ireland's legal system. Changes to this new edition, some of them substantial, have been made to every section taking full account of five years of developments. The book explores the evolution of law making in Northern Ireland before going on to explain the relevant constitutional arrangements, how to identify and interpret applicable sources of law, and what are the fundamental rules and principles of public law, criminal law, and private law, highlighting where appropriate what may be unusual about them. It contextualises the myriad of legal institutions operating in the jurisdiction, sets out how criminal and civil proceedings work in practice, and provides useful information on how people become lawyers, what lawyers actually do once they become qualified, and how the legal system is funded. The appendices set out some sample sources of law so that readers can familiarise themselves with what is involved in handling legal documents. The language throughout is accessible, and there are tables of cases and legislation as well as a comprehensive index.

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
