considered an early example of detective fiction with the hero walter hartright employing many of the sleuthing techniques of later private detectives the use of multiple narrators draws on collins s legal training walter hartright a young art teacher meets a mysterious and distressed woman dressed in white he helps her on her way but later learns that she has escaped from an asylum next day he travels to limmeridge house in cumberland having been hired as a drawing master on the recommendation of his friend pesca an italian language master the limmeridge household comprises the invalid frederick fairlie and walter s students laura fairlie mr fairlie s niece and marian halcombe her devoted half sister walter realises that laura bears an astonishing resemblance to the woman in white who is known to the household and whose name is anne catherick the mentally disabled anne had lived near limmeridge as a child and was devoted to laura s mother who first dressed her in white
