this edited collection opens up new intellectual territories and articulates the ways in which academics are theorising and practicing new forms of research in wild contexts many researchers are choosing to leave the familiarity of their laboratory based settings in order to pursue in situ studies in the wild that can help them to better understand the implications of their work in real world settings this has naturally led to ethical philosophical and practical reappraisals with regard to the taken for granted lab based modus operandi of scientific cultural and design based ways of working this evolving movement has led to a series of critical debates opening up around the nature of research in the wild but up until now these debates have not been drawn together in a coherent way that could be useful in an academic context the book brings together applied methodological and theoretical perspectives relating to this subject area and provides a platform and a source of reference material for researchers students and academics to base their work on cutting across multiple disciplines relating to philosophy sociology ethnography design human computer interaction science history and critical theory this timely collection appeals to a broad range of academics in varying fields of research

over the last 30 years the african wild dog population has declined dramatically dogs have disappeared from 25 of the 39 countries where they were previously found and only 6 populations are believed to number more than 100 today it is believed that only between 3 000 5 500 dogs remain in 600 1 000 packs with most to be found in eastern and southern africa the dramatic reduction in their population is attributed to a number of factors including human population growth and activities deterioration of habitat and contact with domestic dogs and their diseases this action plan explores some of the reasons behind their disappearance and provides a number of proposed solutions split into 3 priority areas ranging from habitat management and conservation to monitoring domestic dogs

although the field of quantitative genetics the study of the genetic basis of variation in quantitative characteristics such as body size or reproductive success is almost 100 years old its application to the study of evolutionary processes in wild populations has expanded greatly over the last few decades during this time the use of wild quantitative genetics has provided insights into a range of important questions in evolutionary ecology ranging from studies conducting research in well established fields such as life history theory behavioural ecology and sexual selection to others addressing relatively new issues such as populations responses to climate change or the process of senescence in natural environments across these fields there is increasing appreciation of the need to quantify the genetic rather than just the phenotypic basis and diversity of key traits the genetic basis of the associations between traits and the interaction between these genetic effects and the environment this research activity has been fuelled by methodological advances in both molecular genetics and statistics as well as by exciting results emerging from laboratory studies of evolutionary quantitative genetics and the increasing availability of suitable long term datasets collected in natural populations especially in animals quantitative genetics in the wild is the first book to synthesize the current level of knowledge in this exciting and rapidly expanding area this comprehensive volume also offers exciting perspectives for future studies in emerging areas including the application of quantitative genetics to plants or arthropods unraveling the molecular basis of variation in quantitative traits or estimating non additive genetic variance since this book deals with many fundamental questions in evolutionary ecology it should be of interest to graduate post graduate students and academics from a wide array of fields such as animal behaviour ecology evolution and genetics

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
